

**Town of Eastover Planning Meeting

Mayor Charles McLaurin called the August 29, 2022, Eastover Town Council meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mr. Ronald Autry, Town Administrator, gave an update on items for the Eastover Ballpark. They are as follows:

- New well is being dug August 29, 2022. The old well only produced 22 gallons of water a minute. For Irrigation purposes the well needs to produce at least 45 gallons of water a minute
- Once the well is finished the irrigation can then be installed, then sodding of the field.
- Eastover Town Council agreed to allow the Eastover Ballpark Association to get bids for the irrigation and sodding.
- Cameras have been installed in the back parking lot. The electrician is going to put up poles for the front cameras to be installed. He will also be installing electricity to the stage.
- The ramp at the stage has been installed and is awaiting the final permit
- The engineering firm used to draw plans on the new bathrooms and picnic shelter is severely behind. The Council agreed to hire a new firm.
- Lights will be installed in the new parking lot by the end of the year
- Lights need to be installed at the pickle ball court as soon as possible. The Council agreed to move forward with this.

The Eastover Ballpark Association will be receiving \$200,000 from the state. The priority is to install new playground equipment over by the splashpad. The next priority is to get new scoreboards and a sound system. They will help build a new pickleball court with any remaining funds.

A motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Bruce Sykes at 7:30p.m. The motion was 2nd by Council Member Lawrence Buffaloe. The vote was unanimous for approval.
